Connected to major European capitals via direct flights or high-speed AVE train (under 2.5 hours from Madrid/Málaga).

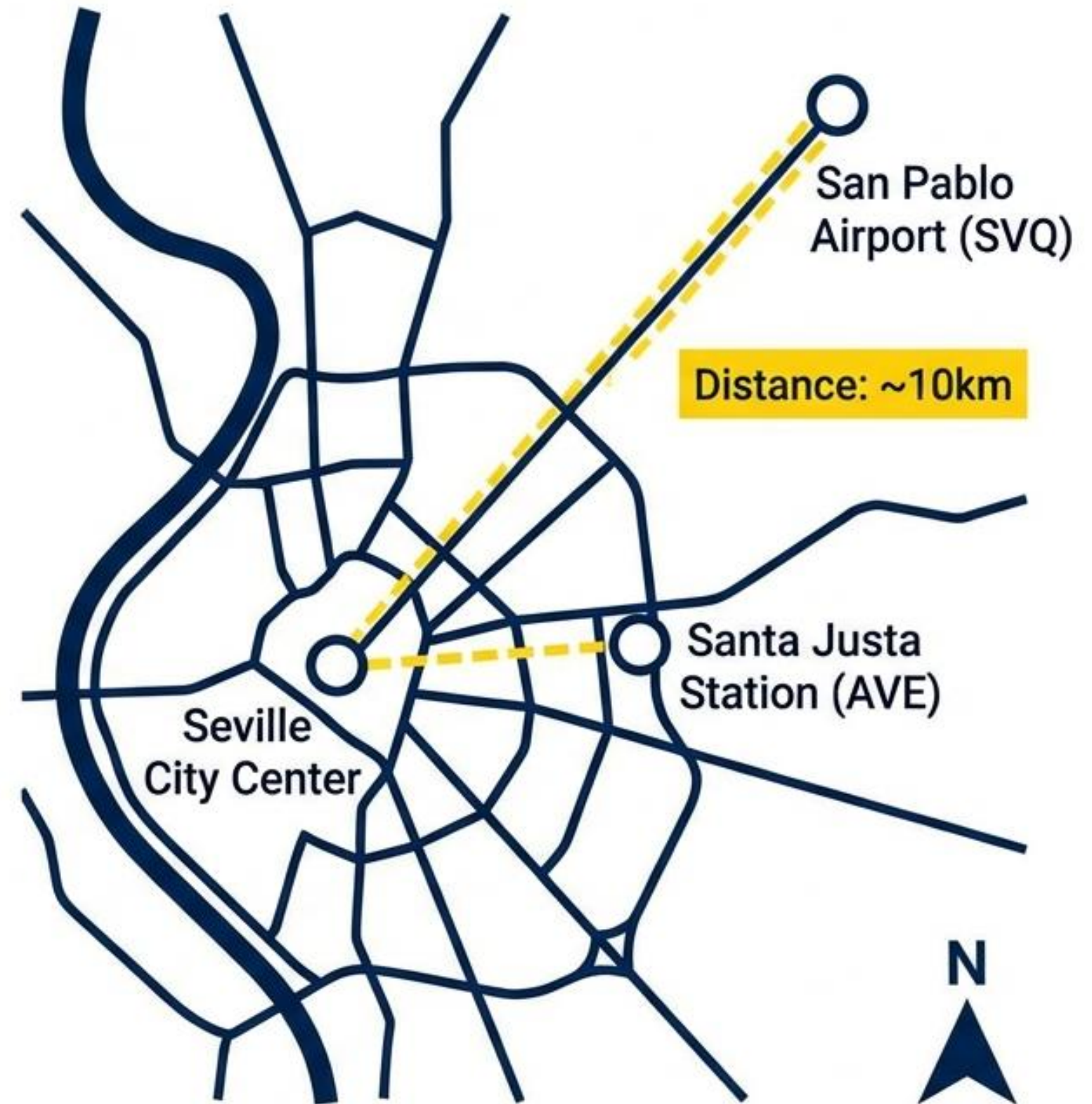


Getting to Seville

Options for arrival include:

- Direct Flight to San Pablo Airport (SVQ).
- Flight to Madrid (MAD) + High-Speed Train (AVE) to Santa Justa Station.
- Flight to Málaga (AGP) + High-Speed Train (AVE) to Santa Justa Station.

If you are landing at San Pablo Airport (SVQ), located 10 kilometers northeast of the city center, this guide outlines the most efficient transfer ways.



Touchdown SVQ: Airport Transfers



App-Based (Cabify)

Open the app upon landing.

CRITICAL: Go to Parking P1, in the designated VTC area. Your driver will wait there.



Taxi (Fixed Rates 2026)

Tarifa 4 (Mon-Fri, 7:00-21:00):
€26 fixed price.

Tarifa 5 (Nights, Weekends,
Holidays): €29 fixed price.

No surprises—these are the official flat rates.



EA Bus

The public transport link.

- Stops: Santa Justa Station, Prado de San Sebastián, Plaza de Armas.

Travel Light: Luggage Logistics

IMPORTANT: Santa Justa Train Station and SVQ Airport do NOT have luggage lockers.



The Solution: Use Stasher

A network of verified hotels and local shops.



Cost: ~€5 per bag/day (insured).



Locations: Over 20 points (Santa Justa, Plaza de Armas, City Center).



Action: Book online via Stasher to secure a spot.

Walking distance to Venue: < 8 Minutes

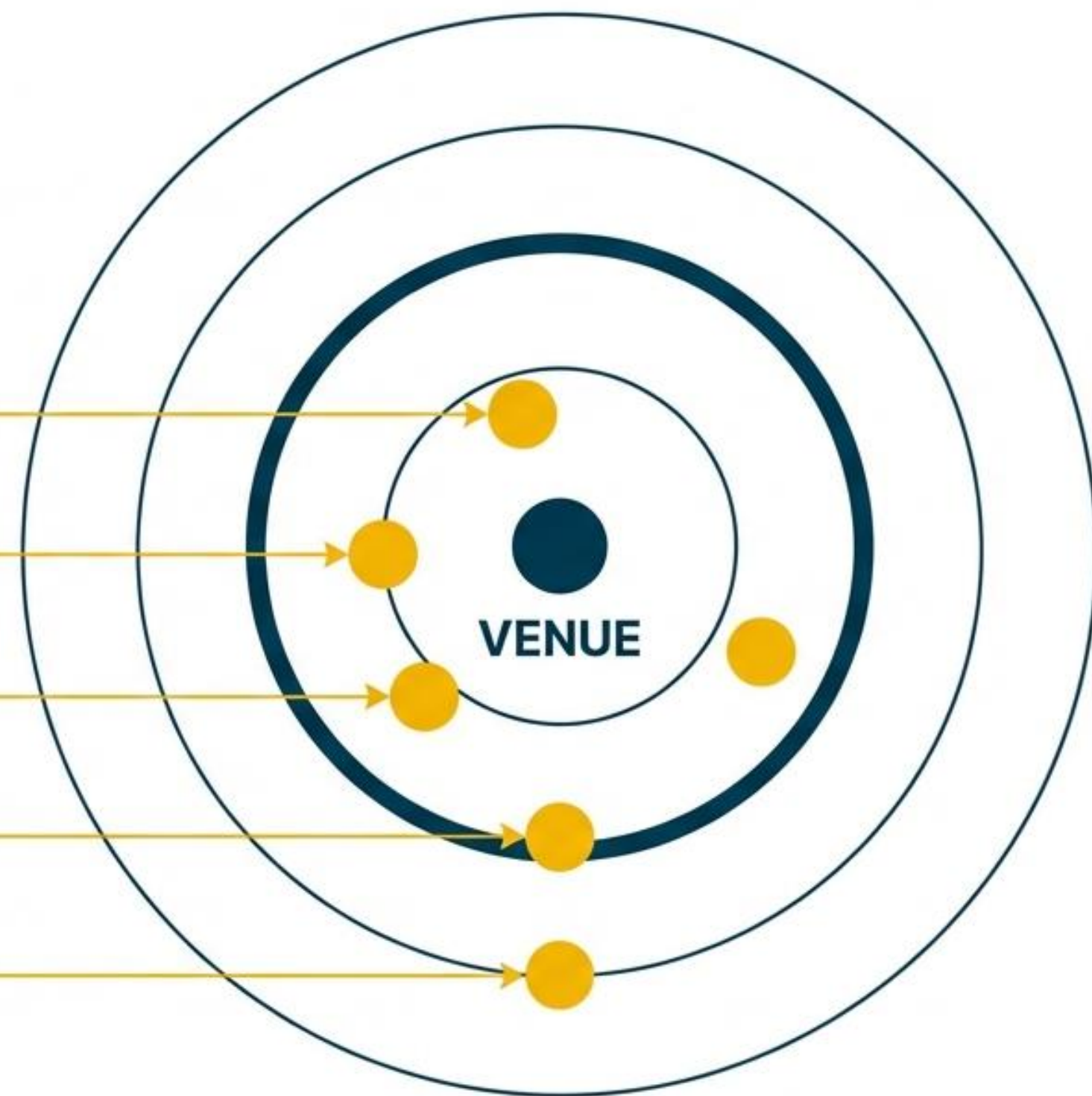

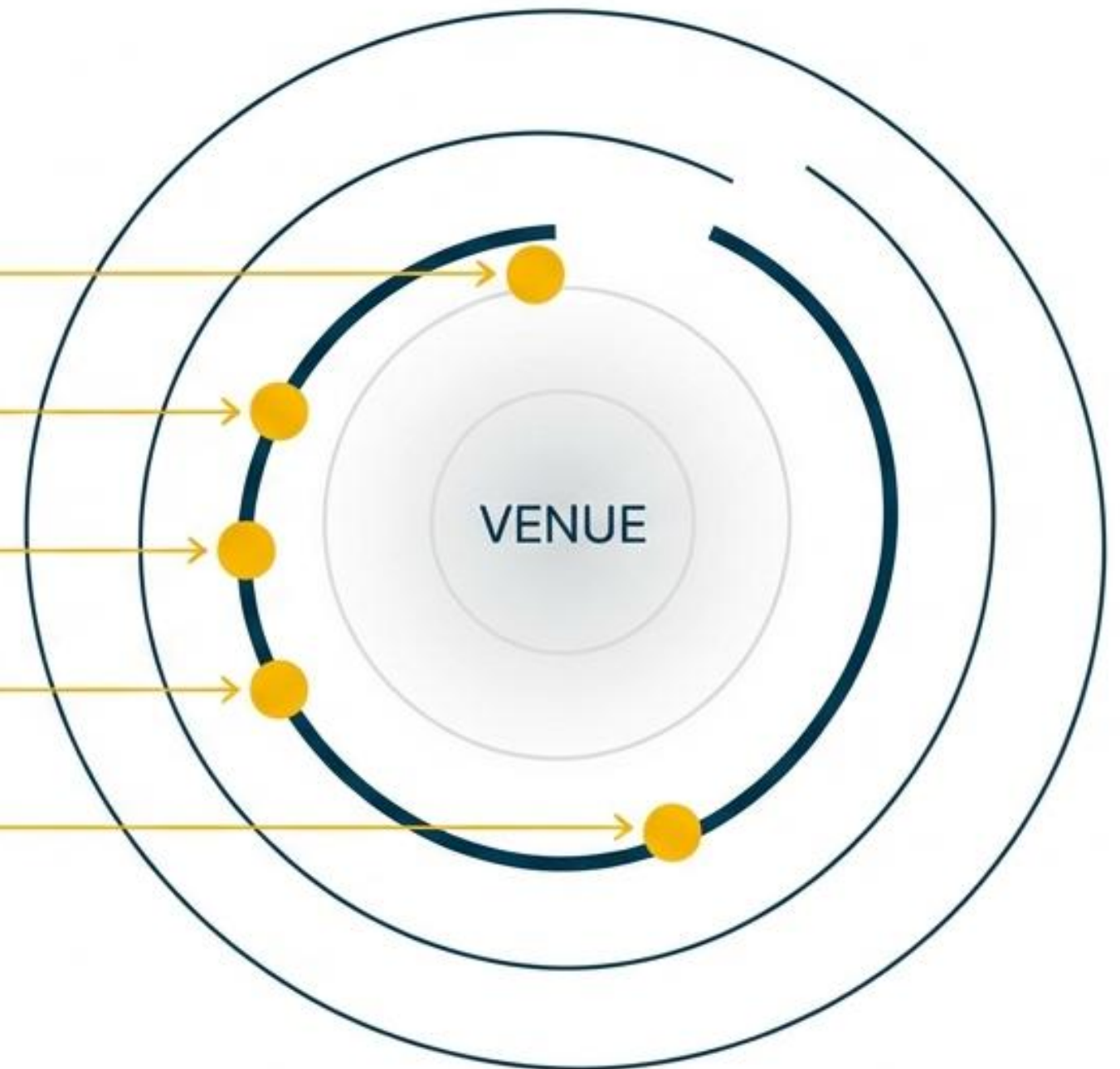

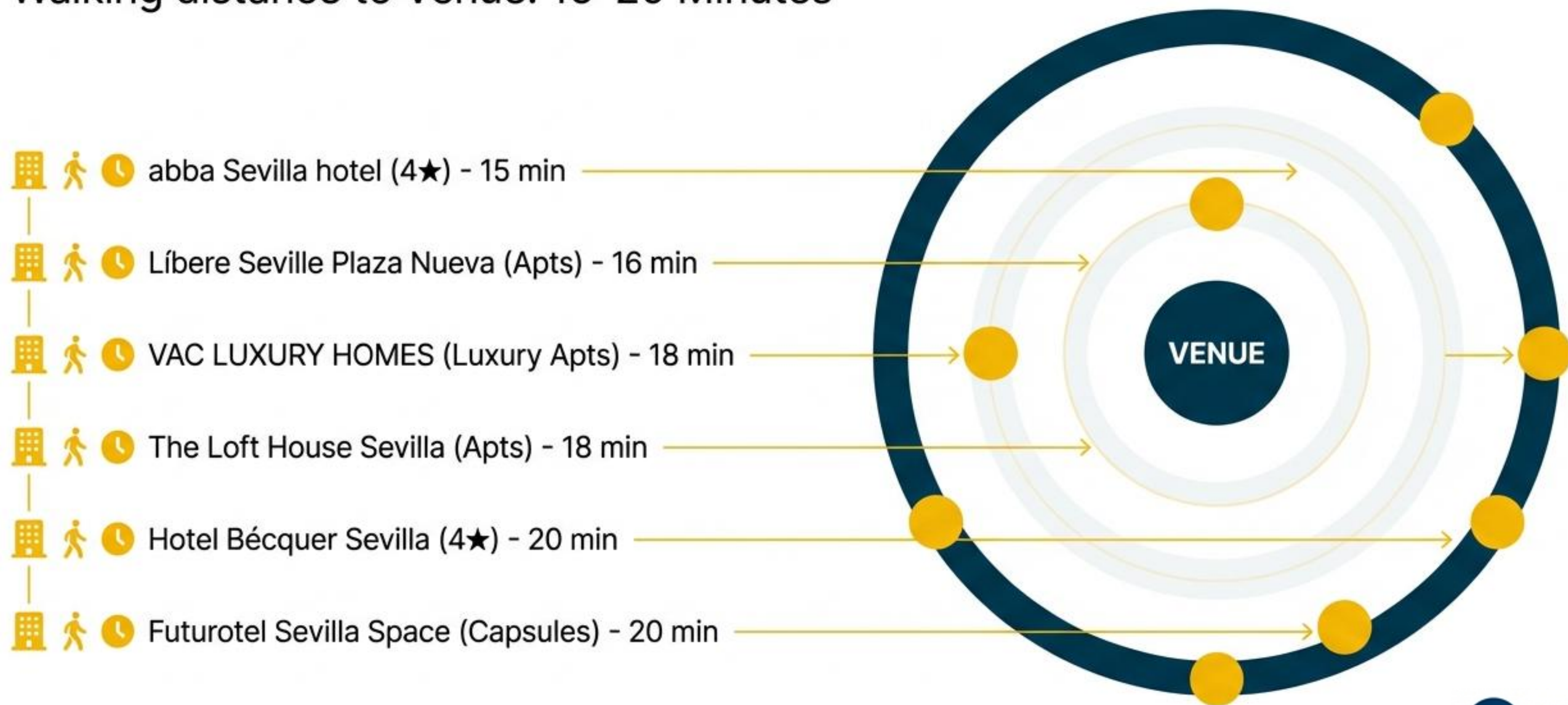
Walking distance to Venue: 10–14 Minutes

Walking distance to Venue: 15–20 Minutes
